The Purpose of the Joint Review Panel (JRP) Community Hearings is to promote the full and open participation of people living near the location of the proposed project...

What can you expect of the JRP Community Hearings?

- ◆ An informal setting.
- ◆ Participants may speak about subjects related to how the proposed Mackenzie Gas Project could affect their lives, their community, the land and the environment.
- ◆ Priority to make presentations and ask questions will be given to people and organizations from the community in which each community hearing is held.
- ◆ People can participate by making presentations in their own languages and in their own ways.

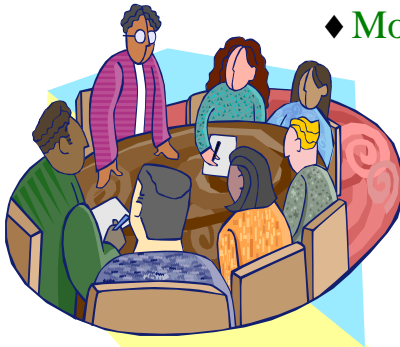


Format of Community Hearings:

- ◆ Opening remarks by Chairperson
- ◆ Presentation by the companies proposing the Project followed by a question/answer period
- ◆ Presentations by participants followed by a question/answer period.

What do you need to know to prepare for the JRP Community Hearings?

◆ Generally, presentations will be limited to 15 minutes.



◆ More than one person can participate in a presentation (but there is still a 15 minute time limit for the entire presentation).

◆ Written submissions are not required but are welcome. Providing copies of written submissions is encouraged, just before speaking, because this will assist the Interpreters.

◆ Anyone who would like to make recommendations to the Panel at a Community Hearing is encouraged to file these recommendations with the Panel Manager 15 days in advance of that hearing session.

◆ Everyone is required to give their name before speaking or giving a written presentation. This is needed for the written record of the Community Hearing.

To help ensure enough time is scheduled for each Community Hearing, all interested participants and organizations are encouraged to contact the Panel Manager before the hearing at which they would like to speak. However, people may sign-up to make a presentation the day of the hearing as well.
